**Têteàtarte**, a cake dish designed by **Paul Baars**, with a column foot divided in 3 parts hiding an illusion. Three faces with their mouth wide open to take a bite. This 'cake dish' is based on an old graphic illusion 'two faces, one vase' (1915) by Danish psychologist Edgar J. Rubin.
